V2 Kitchen - a new Vipp kitchen

How would a Vipp kitchen look made in natural materials? In wood? In Stone? What if we applied the modular system from our first kitchen, the V1, and wrapped it in mother nature's material palette? The result is V2, a new kitchen system where dark oak meets jura marble in a design language that takes us from our roots in Denmark all the way to Japan through a simple and refined aesthetic idiom. The modularity, utilities, and building-block approach, known from the V1, are reused in the V2 kitchen, where predefined units from either tall, wall or island modules.

We did not start from scratch

While stone and oak signify a new material approach, you will recognize Vipp in the use of one of our trademark materials – extruded aluminium. Rounded aluminium profiles with reeded details serve as discreet, integrated drawer and cabinet grips. Drawer constructions and interior fittings like the softly moulded silicone cutlery divider found in the V1 kitchen are repeated in the V2 kitchen.





Cabinet of curiosities

Apart from cabinet fronts covered in dark oak veneer, glass or alu doors apply a playful and refined design element to the V2 kitchen. Both fronts feature a push-click opening mechanism. **The reeded glass doors** framed by anodized aluminium allow for a semi-transparent look into what hides in the cabinet. Visible with closed doors is the integrated lighting, discreetly mounted under each shelf.

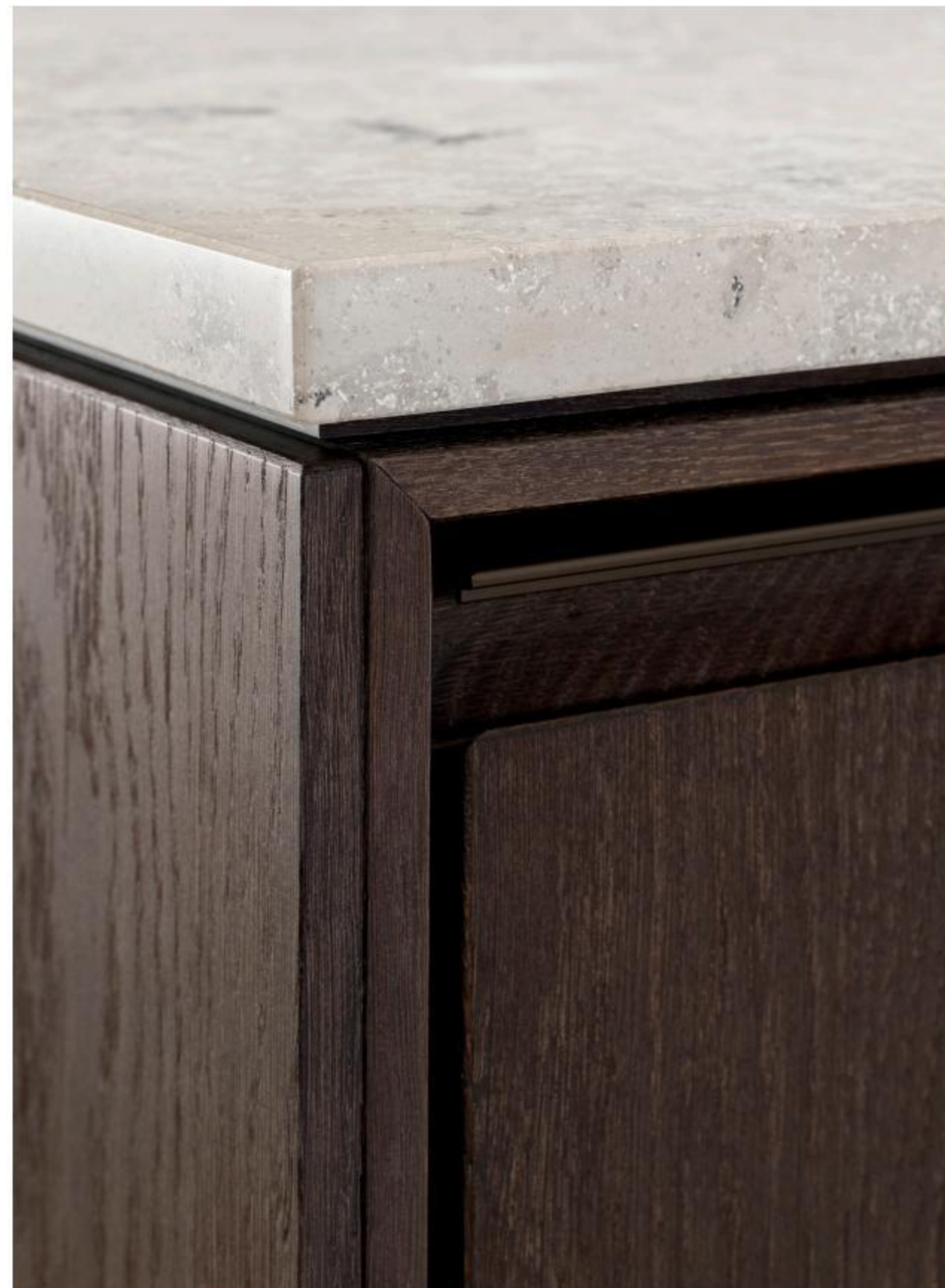
The anodized aluminium doors with vertically extruded profiles equip the V2 with a sophisticated contrast to facades in veneer.

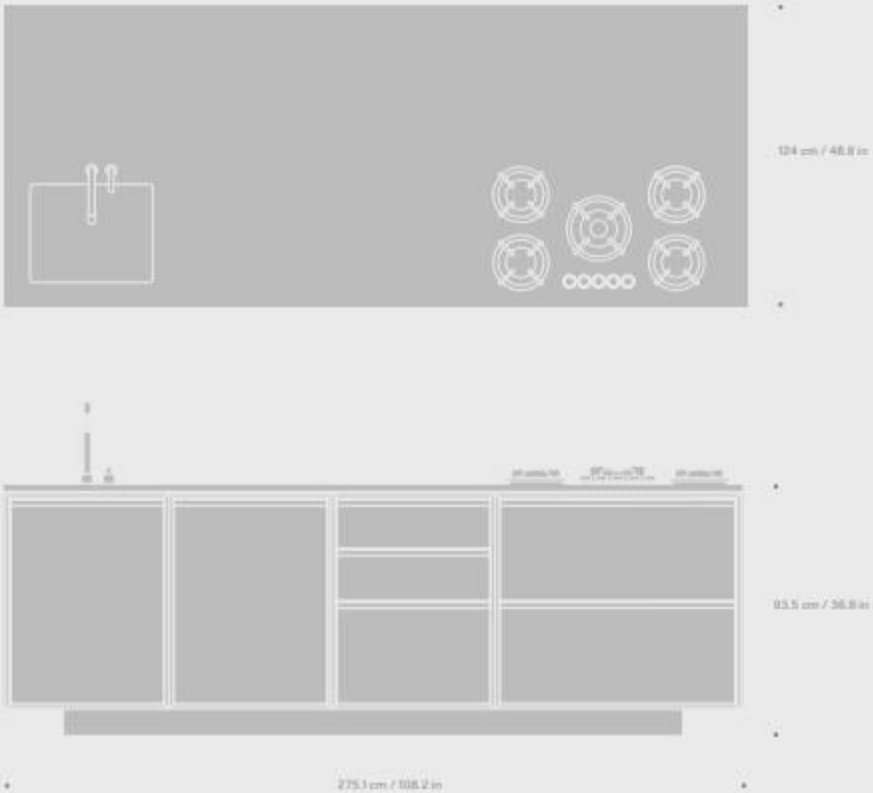
Function meets fossils

In the Alb region in Bavaria, ocean sediments have shaped 'Jura', a dense, fine grained limestone rich in fossils. Combined with carefully carved cabinets in oak sourced in Europe, the V2 confers a new organic tactility to Vipp's functional kitchen system.



Module overview

LARGE ISLAND MODULE



Configuration: 4 units including a sink and a large gas hob.

Front side: 60 cm cabinet with sink - 60 cm dishwasher cabinet - 60 cm two drawers - 90 cm large gas hob with two drawers.

Back side: 2 x 60 cm cabinets - 60 cm two drawers - 90 cm two drawers.

Materials: Oak veneer fronts and sides, Jura marble top, aluminium drawer and cabinet details, stainless steel tap, sink and gas knobs.

Appliances: The appliance package of V1 kitchen is continued.

SMALL ISLAND WITH SEATING EXTENSION



Configuration: 4 units with a 120 cm seating extension.

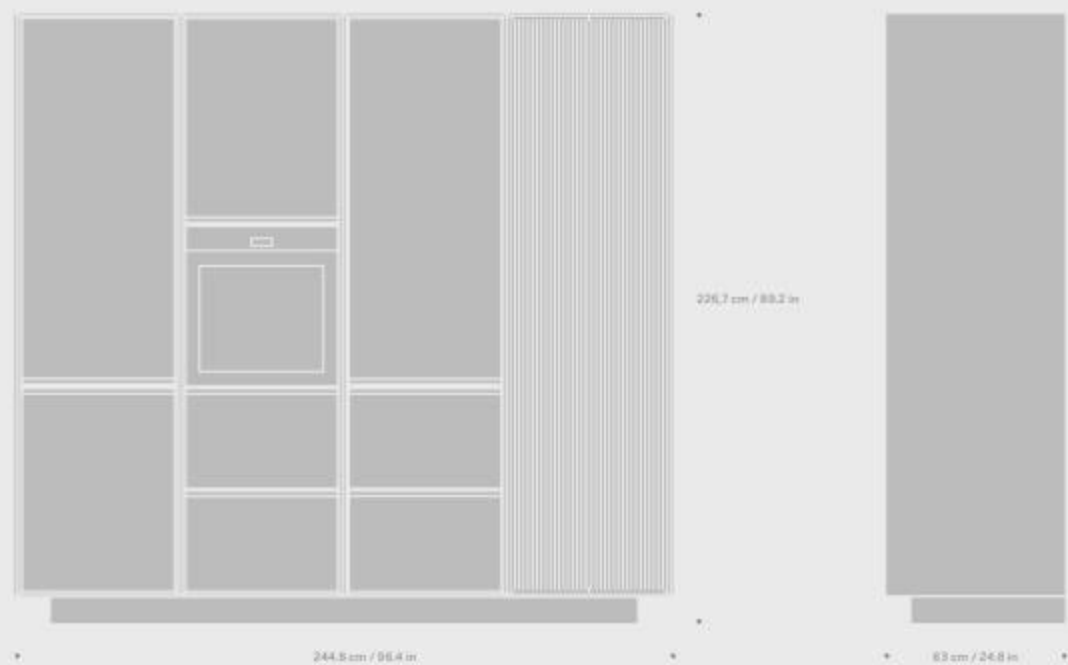
Front side: 2 x 60 cm cabinets - 60 cm three drawers - 60 cm two drawers.

Back side: 4 x 60 cm cabinets (30 cm depth).

Materials: Oak veneer fronts and sides, Jura marble top, aluminium drawer and cabinet details, stainless steel tap, sink, gas knobs and aluminium extension legs.

Appliances: The appliance package of V1 kitchen is continued.

TALL MODULE

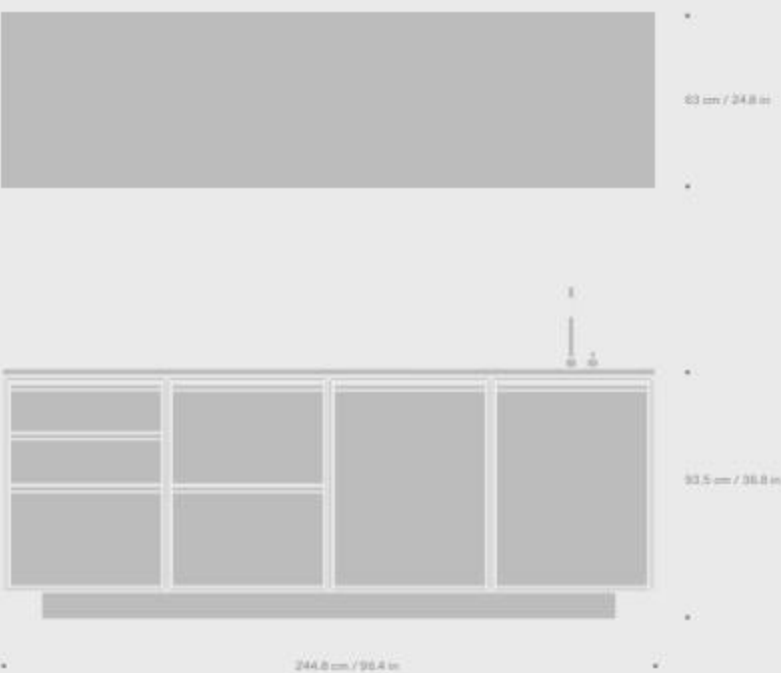


Configuration: 4 units including a refrigerator, freezer and oven
60 cm refrigerator and freezer - 60 cm top cabinet with oven and two bottom drawers
60 cm cabinet with two bottom drawers - 60 cm glass cabinet

Materials: Oak veneer fronts and sides, glass cabinet and aluminium cabinet details

Appliances: The appliance package of V1 kitchen is continued.

WALL MODULE



Configuration: 4 units including a sink and induction
60 cm three drawers - 60cm induction (two drawers) - 60cm cabinet - 60 cm cabinet with sink

Materials: Oak veneer fronts and sides, Jura marble top, aluminium drawer and cabinet details, stainless steel tap and sink.

Appliances: The appliance package of V1 kitchen is continued.
